How to apply for an internship?

Meet with your teacher coach and if needed the internship coordinator. Be sure the register and fill out the Formal Approval Form, more info [here](#).

Master students:

Meet with your mentor and if needed the internship coordinator, more info [here](#).

Eligibility

Bachelor students:

Eligible for an internship when you have completed 90 ECTS before starting the internship (including 60 ECTS of the first year).

Master students:

Eligible to start your preparation FMP (in collaboration with a company abroad) when you have successfully finished project 1 and project 2 (at time of departure).

Timeline

During B2.1 or M1.1 semester: orientation

During B2.2 or M1.2 semester: making arrangements

Bachelors:

Deadline Formal Approval Form: 1 July (for September internships) or 1 December (for February internships).

Masters:

Deadline preliminary and final study program form: check dates and deadlines (more info [here](#)).
