No compulsory attendance 1st take final test*

1st take final test temporarily canceled: the condition that attendance of the 1st take of a final test (on-campus as well as off-campus) is compulsory for participation in the re-sit is temporarily canceled to prevent students with Covid related symptoms to feel obliged to go to campus.
