## Professional Development Preparation

- Request approval from GPD



## Create Professional Development Plan (PDP)

The experience and skills that you gain during the Personal Leadership Experience help you to define and shape the second phase of the Honors Master Program, the Professional Development program.

## Start Professional Leadership Experience

Start Professional Leadership Experience (PLE) course: 8 workshops in small groups, based on the individual, guided by PLE teacher

## Professional Development

- Start doing your PD (project, internship, course, research,...)
- Join Eat, Share & Grow intervention sessions
- Stay in touch with your supervisor and GPD about your project and your own development

Register and organize graduation presentation with PLE teacher, supervisor and GPD.
