## Double degree requirements BA ID

The Double degree Bachelor program, the part of Industrial Design needs to include:

- 135 ECTS of mandatory courses, consisting of Bachelor College Basic Courses (40 ECTS) and mandatory ID Major courses (95 ECTS, including a Final Bachelor Project of 20 ECTS)
- 20 ECTS of electives from the ID curriculum (instead of normal 45 ECTS of electives),
  allowing for some degree of specialization in ID competencies in areas that are not
  closely related to the second program; a preliminary specification of these electives
  needs to be included in the application to the Examination Committee ID, but initial
  choices may however be changed upon approval by the teacher-coach at a later
  stage (provided that the above stated specialization in ID competencies remains
  secured).

Please note that you can combine the FBP's of both programs, which means that your FBP will be 30 ECTS in total. 20 ECTS for the ID program and 10 ECTS for the FBP of the other program. Combining the FBP means that you will be examined on one project, but with the FBP requirements of both departments.

Please check if there is a selection procedure in place for the other Bachelor of your choice. If so, you will need to take part in the selection procedure, since you will start in your first year. Deadline for applying for selection is on January 15, for starting in September after that.

Please note: at your second study you need to fulfill a new BSR. Contact the academic advisor of that study to propose a plan for your BSA to show that you can gain enough credits within an academic year.
