## **Explanation**

After completing the course, the student can perform a literature survey and feasibility study, and make a concrete project description with a detailed project planning.

The preparation graduation project ES is supervised by the graduation tutor and/or graduation supervisor and its objective is to define a concrete Master project. This includes a precisely defined problem statement, an analysis of the state-of-the-art including a thorough literature survey, a description of the expected end result, an outline of the planned research and development approach (possibly already supported by some initial theoretical analyses, a small example or case study, and/or some initial experiments), and a project planning with clearly defined milestones (decision points) and deliverables (results). The student presents the project proposal report to the assessment committee that will also evaluate the Master project.

The preparation project is judged on three criteria: feasibility study, presentation, and report. Each are scored on a number of subcriteria according to the following scale:

U = unsatisfactory S = sufficient G = good

The score "sufficient" represents what can be expected from a student. The preparation project is not graded on a numerical scale; the student either passes or fails. If a student fails the preparation project, then the student needs to do a new preparation project with the same or a different supervisor.

The form should be handed in with the student administration by the supervisor when submitting the result.
