Everything you need to know about your second year AUBS

Welcome back! In the second year of AUBS you will continue at the TU/e Bachelor College by completing the last basic course Engineering Design, and by choosing a USE-trajectory. You will also continue with the major courses that teach you the fundamentals for the BAU-profiles.

B, A, OR U? START YOUR SPECIALIZATION

Last year, you became familiar with the three BAU-profiles. At the Check your Match event you found out which profile fits best to your interests and ambitions. This year you will do four projects within one of the BAU-profiles. The individual projects cover multiple subjects within the profile. E.g., A(UDE) studens have both architecture and urbanism projects; B(PSD) students have both building physics and structural design projects; U(SRE) students have projects involving both urban systems and real estate.

Besides the projects and the mandatory major courses, you will choose elective courses. During year 2 and 3 you can choose from 10 elective courses (four in this year). Within this space, you need at least 1 USE package and at least 1 coherent package from the built environment is recommended. You also need to

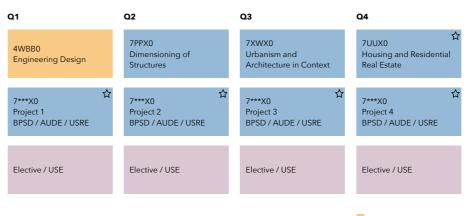
obtain at least 5 Studium Generale USE points and 7 MyFuture Activity points. More information can be found on the educationguide.

COHERENT (ELECTIVE) PACKAGES AND USE

During year 2 and 3 you can choose from two coherent (elective) packages. The coherent packages that combine electives of various subjects make sure that you will achieve sufficient depth in preparation of your master program. You can find an overview of the coherent packages on the Education Guide (educationguide.tue.nl/bc/aubs)

On the Education Guide you can also find an overview of all USE-trajectories. During year 2 and 3 you must complete one USE-trajectory. The USE courses give a perspective on the role of (and implication for) users, society and enterprise in your design and ideas. Make sure to attend at least 5 Studium Generale activities with the USE-logo in the coming two years!

CAREER ORIENTATION AND PROFESSIONAL SKILLS
