# TU/e policy regarding International Experience

- The TU/e finds it important that her graduates have gained an international experience period abroad.
- This international experience can be obtained by doing a mobility period at one of the partner universities abroad.
- The ultimate goal is that every MSc graduate has undertaken an international experience, either during their bachelors or masters.
- Students who have done their prior education abroad are considered as having fulfilled this goal.

## Options during the bachelors program:

- ✓ Bachelor final project (Q4, or any other quarter for those who have a delay in their studies)
- ✓ A semester abroad, upon approval by the Examination committee

## Options during the masters program:

- ✓ 6EMAC4: Research or Design project, 15 ECTS
- ✓ The industrial internship
- ✓ A semester abroad, upon approval by the Examination committee



Due to the tightened measures and the ever-changing travel advice and travel restrictions, until July 2021, the following is applicable:

- The only possibility for an exchange period is to do internships and (research) projects in EEA countries, but countries at risk (orange and red zones) are excluded. Permission must be obtained from the dean of the department in question.
- It is thus not possible to take courses at partner universities in EEA and non-EEA countries, nor to do internships and (research projects) in non-EEA countries.
