The committee assigns a final grade to the Master Thesis Project between 1 and 10 (half grades are allowed, e.g. 6.5 or 8.5).

- Excellent (9 = top 10%): thesis shows deep understanding of the topic, a substantial degree of creative engagement with the issues; faultless exposition is clearly structured around a central thesis, and has clear signs of independent thought;
- Good pass (8): very clear and accurate exposition, good understanding of topic, structured around a central thesis, signs of independent thought;
- Sufficient (7 or 5.5): reasonably clear and accurate exposition, structured around a central thesis, adequate grasp of topic, transcending the course materials. Exhibits rather basic, but still acceptable, level of relevant knowledge and understanding. Faults in exposition may to some extent be compensated for by evidence of independent thought;
- Insufficient (< 5.5): fails to make low pass grade because of insufficiency in one or more of the criteria.

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
