

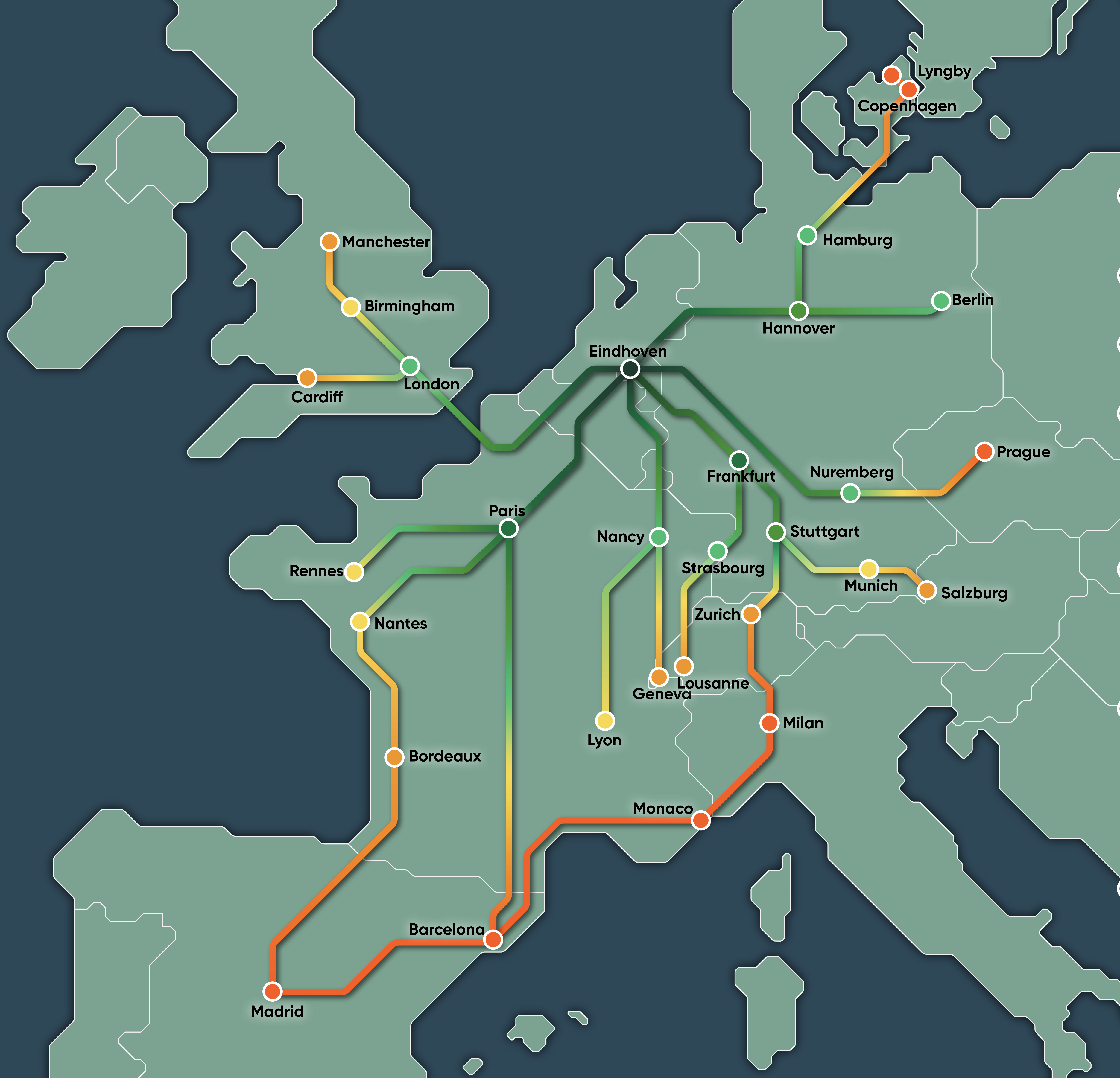
The European train map
